Rutland Round

Saturday 20th - Thursday 25th May

The Rutland Round is a 65-mile circular route around the perimeter of the county, with its start and finish in Oakham and a couple of detours to visit Rutland Water. The 65-mile led walk will be split into six days starting on Saturday 20th May and finishing on Thursday 25th May. You can book to walk as many sections as you like or why not take on the challenge of the full Rutland Round.
