Job Purpose: implementation and deployment of all quality assurance processes, delivery

and evaluation of Institute of Swimming commercial programmes

Scope and Accountabilities

- Responsible for ensuring the legal requirements for health & safety, safeguarding, data protection and Equality and Diversity are met within programme delivery.
- Lead the assessment and appeals procedure for awarding organisation and Institute of Swimming provision.
- Monitor and review internal and external verification reports, and address any concerns to maintain excellent standards of provision.
- Responding to resolve complaints, escalating them to the Institute of Swimming Quality Assurance and Funded Training Manager when required.
- Support the Institute of Swimming trainee tutor workforce through their programme.
- Maintain quality and accreditation of the Institute of Swimming CPD suite with awarding organisations.

Working Relationships

- Carry out workforce training and updates as required to the tutor workforce, and registered awarding organisations.
- Work with tutors and presenters to ensure that the health and safety policy is adhered to
- Maintain strong relationships with Learn to Swim, Business Engagement and Educator Training teams to regularly update on new initiatives and changes to qualifications.
- Responsible for contact with awarding organisations as agreed with the Institute of Swimming Quality Assurance and Funded Training Manager.
- Work collaboratively with the Learning Solutions Team to produce high quality courses and resources to achieve excellent standards across all Institute of Swimming provision.

Influence

- To intervene in cases of sub-standard provision and when legal requirements are not being met within Institute of Swimming provision.
- To support action plans for tutors when delivery standards are not being met (i.e. Tutors graded as requiring improvement or inadequate).
- Support the Quality Assurance and Funded Training Manager in the production and development of policies and procedures and maintain their accuracy working with policy owners.
- Recognises the bigger picture by understanding the impact the tutor workforce has on the organisations business objectives.

- Assess and quality assure assessment materials and assessment decisions within Institute of Swimming provision.
- Be responsible for the block and release of assessment decisions to maintain the quality of Institute of Swimming provision.
- Assist in the development of new projects and qualifications as required within own area of knowledge and expertise.

Deliverables:

- Plan and co-ordinate the tutor observation schedule across all regions in England.
- Analyse and resolve issues that have caused blocking of results on Institute of Swimming commercial provision.
- Monitoring that the appropriate checks have been carried out on all Institute of Swimming delivery sites. This includes health and safety, safeguarding, normal operating and emergency action procedures.
- Assist with co-ordination of training and focus groups.
- Assist in the production, implementation and maintenance of a quality improvement plan to meet with different awarding organisations requirements
- Produce data and feedback reports for the management team to demonstrate performance across all aspects of Institute of Swimming provision.
- The post holder will carry out any other duties as are within the scope, spirit and purpose of the job as requested by the line manager or Head of Department.
- The post holder will proactively comply with and promote all organisation policies, in particular those relating to Equality and Diversity and Health & Safety.
