

Effective & Sustainable Use of the Primary PE and Sport Premium

Schools can use their Primary PE and Sport Premium to:

- ✓ Provide staff with professional development, mentoring, training and resources to help them teach PE and sport more effectively
- ✓ Hire qualified sports coaches to work with teachers to enhance or extend current opportunities
- ✓ Introduce new sports, dance or other activities to encourage more pupils to take up sport and physical activities
- ✓ Support and involve the least active children by providing targeted activities, and running or extending school sports and holiday clubs
- ✓ Enter or run more sport competitions
- ✓ Partner with other schools to run sports activities and clubs
- ✓ Increase pupils' participation in the School Games
- ✓ Encourage pupils to take on leadership or volunteer roles that support sport and physical activity within the school
- ✓ Provide additional swimming provision targeted to pupils not able to meet the swimming requirements of the national curriculum
- ✓ Embed physical activity into the school day through active travel to and from school, active playgrounds and active teaching

The Primary PE and Sport Premium should NOT be used to:

- ✗ Employ coaches or specialist teachers to cover planning preparation and assessment (PPA) arrangements - these should come out of your core staffing budgets
- ✗ Teach the minimum requirements of the national curriculum - including those specified for swimming (or, in the case of academies and free schools, to teach your existing PE curriculum)
