

New Age Kurling



Format

Round Robin
Tournament. This could be a competition between bubbles or house groups

Equipment

Kurling Stones (x4 Blue, x4 Red) and target (Alternate equipment could be bean bags as stones and tape or flat spot to mark the target)

Teams

2 teams 4 vs 4 (can range from 1vs1 to 4vs4.)

Game timing/ Scoring

2 ends, or 15 mins timed games

Court Layout

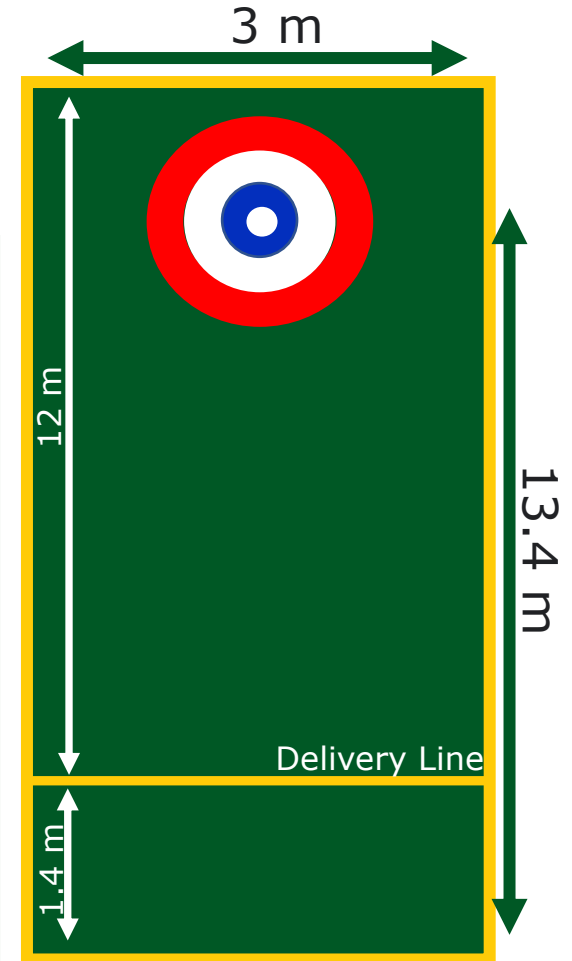
Court 13.4m x 3m or half badminton court (length-ways)

Rules

- The red side always starts the first throw.
- The end is completed when all stones from both sides have been played.

Scoring

1. Only stones that reach the red, white or blue on the target will count.
2. The stone that is closest to the centre at the end of a round will score a point.
3. Other stones that are closer to the centre of the same colour will also score.
4. The only possible scores a round are 0-0, 1-0, 2-0, 3-0 and 4-0.



New Age Kurling

Space: Court 13.4m x 3m or half badminton court (length-ways).

Task:

1. The stone closest to the centre at the end of a round will score a point.
2. Other stones that are closer to the centre of the same colour will also score.
3. The only possible scores a round are 0-0, 1-0, 2-0, 3-0 and 4-0

Equipment: Kurling Stones (x4 Blue, x4 Red) and target

People: 2 teams 4 vs 4 (can range from 1vs1 to 4vs4.)
