Rules and Regulations of Team Leicestershire Netball

1. Rules of the Game

All games will played to the IFNA rules of the game http://www.netball.org/netball/the-rules-of-netball

2. Playing Qualification

All teams need to have membership to Team Leicestershire

3. Age Banding

Players should not play in a lower age group to their academic school year Players can only play in one age group per season across Team Leicestershire and National Schools Netball Competition.

4. Squad Members

Maximum of 12 players in a squad 7 players selected for the team Minimum of 5 players must take to the court to constitute a match

5. Format

Each member school will play each other once in their league Venue to be agreed by both teachers 10 minute per quarter games which may be reduced with the agreement of both teachers (not increased)

6. Results

Each individual teacher is responsible for entering their own results on the **Team Leicestershire community of the Virtual Together app** (see further information at the end of this handbook RE: links and user guides)

7. Forfeited Games

Games must be cancelled by 1pm of the agreed date

The non-offending team will be allocated 10 – 0 win with points accordingly
